**Exercise Classes Slated  
To Begin Next Month**

SCOTCH PLAINS – The Jewish Community Center of Central New Jersey, in partnership with the Arthritis Foundation, will conduct a six-week exercise program beginning in January.

Classes will be held on Mondays and/or Wednesdays from 11:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. The Monday classes will start on January 8 and the Wednesday classes will begin on January 24.
