Darnell H. Doyle Participates In Peace-Keeping Mission

SCOTCH PLAINS - Army Private First Class Darnell H. Doyle is one of approximately 2,900 soldiers assigned to the 10th Mountain Division, Light Infantry, at Fort Drum, Watertown, N.Y., who has deployed to Bosnia in support of Operation Joint Forge (OJF).

OJF is a NATO-led joint, multinational peacekeeping mission in Bosnia-Herzegovina. It is part of a continuing effort by the United States in support of the United Nations mission to maintain peace and stability in the region in compliance with the

Balkan Accords.

The division soldiers' mission in Bosnia is to deter hostility, stabilize and maintain peace by ensuring a safe, secure environment. The troops are replacements for the First Calvary Division based at Fort Hood, Tex.

Mr. Doyle is an infantryman normally assigned to the 31st Infantry. He is the son of Loretta Doyle of Scotch Plains. His wife, Latasha, is the daughter of King Murray of Georgia.

He is a 1995 graduate of Essex County College in Newark.

Roosevelt Announces First Period Honor Roll For 7th and 8th Grades
